Camp Meeting is just two and a half months away!

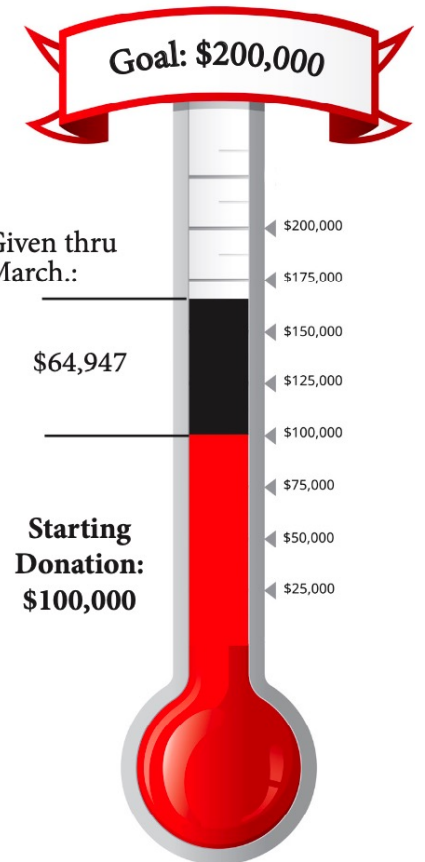
The building permit for the new Medical Building is now in hand and work on the foundation is able to move forward.
